FOOTBALL EXCELLENCE AT CORINDA



The Football Excellence (FEX) program offers students the opportunity to improve their football ability and awareness whilst completing their secondary education. Delivered by highly qualified staff and supported by industry partnerships, the program was established in 2011 and is one of many Excellence programs offered at Corinda.

Past FEX students have met continued success over the years with players representing Brisbane Roar Academy & QAS programs as well as English WSL Academy league and international teams.

Our aim is to provide a unique opportunity for students to develop their athletic goals while introducing them to all facets of football. Students will engage in fitness conditioning and nutrition for performance, to skill acquisition and learning strategies. In addition, the program prides itself on developing the whole individual; fostering students' development in their relationships, identity, emotional skills, and overall wellbeing so that they can reach their full potential.

COURSE OVERVIEW

The FEX program is designed for students in Years 7-12.

Year 7	4.5 lessons per week
Years 8 - 10	5 lessons per week
Years 11 - 12	3 lessons per week

Additional training sessions, before and after school, may be required when preparing for upcoming competitions. Junior students will participate in:

- Football & futsal skill development
- Fitness training for football & futsal
- Strength training
- Stretching, flexibility and recovery sessions
- Theoretical Health & Physical Education units
- Participation in various district, regional, state and national competitions

Year 10 students participate in a program designed specifically for Football Performance in preparation for Elite Pathways and assessment completion of theoretical coursework, which contributes to their ATAR. Years 11 and 12 focus purely on Football Performance.

SELECTION CRITERIA

To be eligible for participation in FEX, application must be of an acceptable standard across academic, behaviour and football achievements. An ideal applicant will possess:

- A high standard of football skills & technical ability.
- The ability to work productively in a positive team environment.
- An exemplary record of attitude, industry and behaviour within a school community.
- The capacity to cover course costs.
- A passion to pursue FEX and promote football in all of its facets.
- A desire to demonstrate cooperation, courtesy and commitment at all times.
