KEY INFORMATION



OFFICE HOURS

The main school reception is open 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM on school days and located downstairs in the Administration Building (corner of Lynne Grove Avenue & Pratten Street).

STUDENT SERVICES

Our Student Services are located on the ground floor of the Administration Building. This incorporates:

- Late arrivals & early departures
- Uniform slips
- General student services
- Sick Bay
- Payment Office
- Lost Property

The Payments Office is open Monday to Friday from 8:00 AM - 1:30 PM.

TRANSPORT

Council parking restrictions apply at the front of the school, and they actively patrol these areas. During peak traffic times, please be extra cautious of pedestrians, considerate of all drivers, and do not park in bus zones or in front of private driveways.

Please note, parking is not permitted inside school grounds during school hours. Visitors are required to utilise street parking.

UNIFORM SHOP

We use The School Locker Oxy for all uniform requirements. Visit the school website for hours.

TUCKSHOP & CAFE

The Tuckshop is located in C Block and open daily from 8:00 AM - 1:35 PM. Payment is taken by debit card and a CSHS student card which students can top up with money via the My Student Account platform. The Backstage Brew Cafe is open before school and during first and second breaks.

YONDR

Our school is a mobile phone-free space. All students will be provided with a YONDR mobile pouch which closes with a magnetic lock. Unlocking stations are located on all school gates and students are required to secure their phones in their YONDR upon entering campus.

ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES

LATE ARRIVALS

Students arriving late to school are required to sign in at Student Services, located on the ground floor of the Administration Building.

Students are required to provide a note from parents/carers on arrival. Alternatively, an email from a parent/carer should be sent to absence@corindashs.eq.edu.au advising of the late start.

EARLY DEPARTURES

Student Services require an email or note from a parent or carer prior to the student's scheduled departure.

Students are required to collect a Leave Request slip from Student Services prior to the start of the school day. They must then sign-out and collect a Leave Pass at the time of departure.

RESEARCH & INNOVATION CENTRE (RIC)

LIBRARY HOURS

The Library is located on the top floor of the RIC building, and is open from Monday - Friday, 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM.

Student Clubs and free tutoring sessions are available after school. Please ask your student to visit the Library or check Student Notices on Daymap for more information.

ICT & BYOD

Our Information & Communication Technology (ICT) staff are located in the RIC (second floor) and are available during break times and before and after school to assist students with ICT requirements.
