This funding will be used to

- Improve Writing across all year levels impacting on A – E levels of achievement, national benchmarking and senior schooling outcomes.
- Continued focus on improving classroom pedagogy, student engagement and student agency.
- Continue implementation of full inclusion across the school.
- Decrease number of students with repeated school disciplinary absences.
- Improve attendance and engagement rates for all students.
- Improve total fitness of all students – wellbeing, positive education, school culture.
- Maintain high standards and expectations with QCE attainment, ATAR outcomes and continue improvement in Senior Schooling outcomes.

Our initiatives include

- Classroom Climate surveys – implementation of student voice and developing a culture of feedback to improve student engagement and pedagogy.
- Diagnostic testing using AllWell testing to obtain benchmark data on students in years 7 and 10.
- Develop teacher capacity to deliver explicit teaching of reading, writing and feedback in all classrooms.
- Conduct school improvement walkthroughs with Leadership team to assess variance across the school and identify focus for teaching and learning improvements.
- Provide support for students at risk of disengagement, home visits, intervention programs with key staff who oversee student tracking.
- Implementation of Academic Coaching to improve senior student outcomes, tracking of data and assessment of total fitness.
- Monitor attendance rates and implement proactive strategies to address attendance and engagement.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ Deputy Principal – Teaching & Learning to lead improvements with pedagogy and classroom delivery. (\$166 000)
- Employ additional Literacy and Numeracy HODs (.5 each) to support focus on literacy and numeracy improvements. (\$150 000)
- Employ part time HOD to support school's focus on Feedback to improve student outcomes and pedagogy. (\$30 000)
- Employ additional House Masters to support pastoral care, school climate and wellbeing initiatives. (\$560 000)
- Employ school engagement officer and Youth Support Coordinator to improvement engagement and student completion rates. (\$204 000)
- Employ additional Guidance Officer (.5) to support student programs and engagement. (\$78 400)
- Employ additional Senior Schooling Head of Department to support Year 12 outcomes. (\$112 500)
- Allocate Teacher Aide hours to support data tracking with Senior ATAR students. (\$14 351)
